### GCSE Results 2019

We were pleased to report another set of positive GCSE examination results and delighted with the progress our students have made, with 54% of students achieving a grade 4 or above in English and mathematics.

We were particularly pleased with our science results, where 70% of students achieved a grade 4 or higher with a quarter of students gaining a grade 7 or above. In English, 61% of students achieved a grade 4 or higher and in mathematics 63% of students achieved a grade 4 or above. The significant increase in the number of top grades demonstrates our high expectations and the hard work and determination of staff and students.

We are incredibly proud of all of our students and the outcomes they have achieved, especially Marianna Birkett and Sophia Dubery who achieved seven or more grade 9s including mathematics and English, as well as Millie Ball, Adam Moore, Martyna Ragauskaite and Josh Stayton who also secured outstanding GCSE results.

We would like to congratulate the students on their GCSE results and wish them every success in the future.
